

The Division believes that for the safety of its students and employees and as a part of its responsibility to the environment, hazardous conditions should be rectified

Accordingly, the Division supports WHMIS (Workplace Hazardous Materials Information Services) practises and procedures in all its operations. WHMIS procedures, including identification of hazardous materials and the use of WHMIS data sheets for all hazardous materials are required to be kept current and are expected to be available in any area where potential hazardous materials are located. The Division will support staff development for employees working with WHMIS defined materials.

Concerns regarding hazardous conditions are to be relayed immediately to the building supervisor or Maintenance Supervisor.
