

Benito School Goals – Snapshot

1. Math –

- With consistent teaching using NAP, students in Gr.5-8 will see an increase in overall success
- With more math time scheduled there is more time to focus on building mental math skills and having specific word problem practice.

2. Literacy –

- All staff working with ELA will embrace the UFLI Curriculum for K-4 and will use it for intervention in grades 5-8.
- We will see an improvement in articulation and speech in those students that struggle to speak clearly
- We will see an improvement in literacy and reading skills, especially in K-4.
- Teachers and resource will familiarize themselves with and utilize the Diebels assessment.
- ELA curriculum will be more fluid/creative and individualized to support the new ELA curriculum

3. Building Staff Capacity

- All teachers and EA's will be confident with the new performance and evaluation process, goal setting and rubrics.
- The ICT and digital citizenship/health will be more thoroughly covered with designated scheduling.

4. Whole School Approach to Discipline (year 2)

- All staff will continue to support a united school approach to classroom management, discipline and consequences with the newly established bottom lines (physical violence, verbal violence, defiance/refusal and illegal) and will use the flow chart to know how to handle situations
- Restitution will continue to be discussed and practiced with all staff and students

5. Indigenous Education (Mamahtawisiwin)– to move from exploring to emerging with a focus on:

- Promoting authentic involvement of Knowledge Keepers and Elders
- Increasing understanding of world views, values, identities, traditions and lifestyles

6. Building community/parent support

- Create intentional opportunities to get parents involved and build trust
- Clearly communicate expectations and opportunities for involvement
- Model being an inclusive school and create visuals that communicate that we all belong
