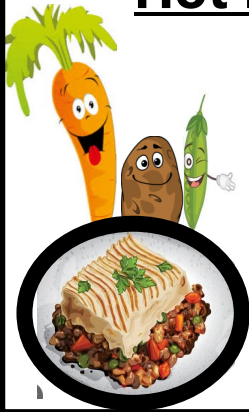




Hot Lunch May 16th!

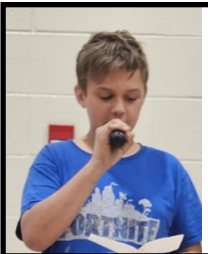

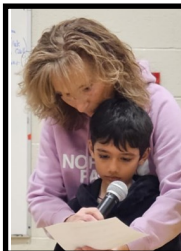

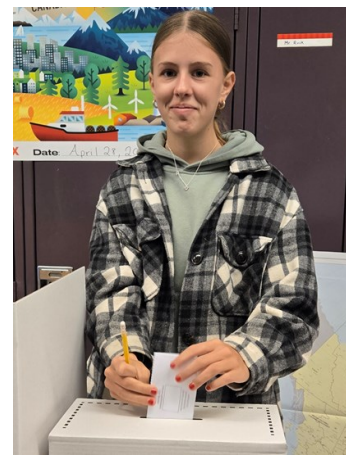

Benito School's Valley Champs Badminton Team

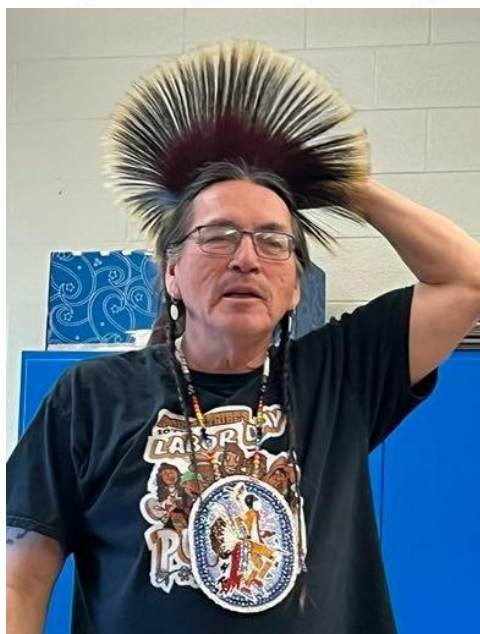

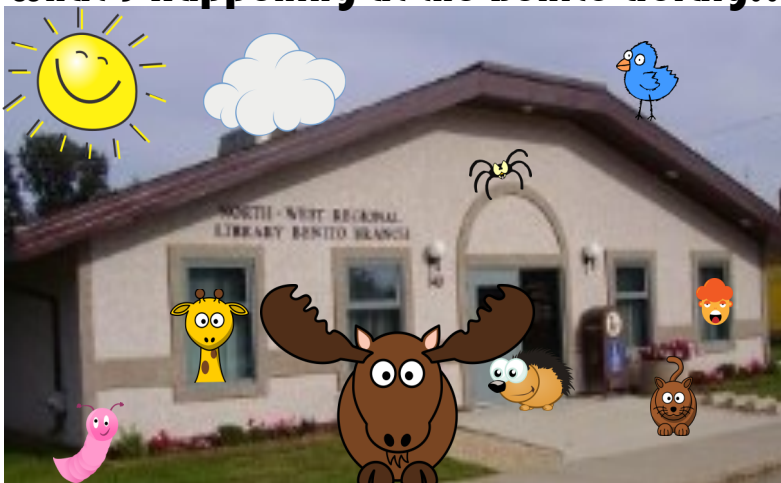
