Did you know:

Reading 4 books improves the summer slide by 85%.

Reading 12 books is equivalent to attending summer school.

Teachers can spend the first 60 days in the fall helping students recover their lost academic knowledge.

Summer is a time when children forget to read. Kids who don't read during the summer can lose up to 3 months of reading progress.

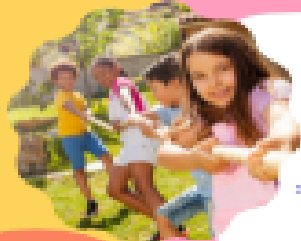
