#### **Bus Safety and Cancellations**

 $\underline{Safety}$ : Please talk to your child about travelling safely. Explain why it is important for the driver to be able to concentrate on the road and why it is important to stay seated. Set the example and expectations by demonstrating safe travel while in a car. Parents, please know that the bus driver is unable to drop off your child at home after school if no one is home, and the child is under 12 years old.

<u>Cancellations</u>: Due to severe weather conditions that may occur, school buses may not be running and may be cancelled for the day. Bus cancellations will be broadcast on CJ104, local FM, CKDM Dauphin, Fox FM, and CJGX Yorkton.
