### Halloween Treats


Taylor School has a school wide Nutrition Policy



### Please Help Us.....

- ...by keeping your child's toys at home for the school day. It is sometimes difficult to find misplaced cars, dolls, etc. There is equipment for students to play with during recess.
- ...by not parking or stopping in the yellow painted curb areas in front of the school or in the middle of the street to drop off or pick up your children. Students must use the crosswalks. Safety patrols have been trained and are ready to guide students.
- ...by adhering to our school zone speed limit of 30km.
- ...by dressing your child appropriately for the changing weather.
- ...by calling the school to let us know when your child is absent.

### **Bus Safety and Cancellations**

<u>Safety</u>: Please talk to your child about travelling safely. Explain why it is important for the driver to be able to concentrate on the road and why it is important to stay seated. Set the example and expectations by demonstrating safe travel while in a car. Parents, please know that the bus driver is unable to drop off your child at home after school if no one is home, and the child is under 12 years ald

<u>Cancellations</u>: Due to severe weather conditions that may occur, school buses may not be running and may be cancelled for the day. Bus cancellations will be broadcast on CJ104, local FM, CKDM Dauphin, Fox FM, and CJGX Yorkton. Your bus driver may also contact you to inform of cancellations, or you can check the division website at www.svsd.ca .
