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Hi Everyone,

It's the time of the year to start thinking about our upcoming school ski trips for those in grade 7-8. We will once again be heading up to Thunderhill Ski Area on the following two dates:

Ski Trip #1: Thursday, Feb. 9th

Ski Trip #2: Thursday, March 9th

We will be leaving the school by bus at approximately 9:15 am and will be returning back to school for buses at 3:30 pm. With this being a higher risk activity, there are a few forms to fill out, so please see attached and return to myself, or your homeroom teacher at the school by no later than Wednesday, January 25th. **If forms are not handed in, or are incomplete, your child will not be allowed to ski that day.** Try and be as accurate as possible with heights and weights, as this will factor into ski length, din setting, etc for your rental. **NOTE- SNOWBOARD RENTALS ARE NOT AVAILABLE FOR SCHOOL TRIPS.**

The weekday group rate for schools is \$25.00 for each trip (\$50.00 covers both ski trips). Please note that **seasonal passes, if you have one, do not apply to school ski trips.** This fee includes your child's lift ticket, (and if needed) rental, a 1 hour lesson, and MB School Board Mandatory Helmet. **If you have your own equipment (snowboard, skis, etc), I will be transporting equipment up to the hill in my personal vehicle on both days.**



This is including but not limited to the inherent risks of ski lifts, collision with natural or man made objects or other skiers, travel within or beyond the ski boundaries, or negligence. We agree that Thunderhill Ski Club Inc. and its employees, agents & volunteers shall not be liable for any such personal injury, death or property loss incurred by the undersigned participant, parent/guardian or his/her estate. EQUIPMENT

SKIING: I understand that the ski boot/binding system may not release during every fall or may release unexpectedly. The ski boot/binding system is no guarantee that the user will not be injured.

SNOWBOARDING: I understand that the boot/binding system is not designed to or intended to release and will not release under normal circumstances. I understand that as the boot/binding system is a non-release system, this system will not reduce the risk of injury during a fall.

SNOWSHOES: I understand the boot/clasp/buckle system is not designed to intended to release and will not release under normal circumstances. I understand that the clasp/buckle system is a non-release system and it will not reduce risk of injury during a fall.

HELMETS: I understand that a helmet designed for RECREATIONAL SNOW SPORT use will help reduce the risk of some types of injuries to the user at slower speeds. I recognize that serious injury or death can result from both low and high energy impacts, even when a helmet is worn.

ALPINE RESPONSIBILITY CODE Thunderhill Ski Club Inc. requires that you know and obey the Responsibility Code. Skiers always SKI UNDER CONTROL AND BE ABLE TO STOP AND AVOID COLLISION WITH OTHERS OR OBJECTS.

_____ **Type II Skier:** Ski moderately. Prefer a variety of speeds. Ski on varied terrain, including most difficult trails.
