Instructions for booking Parent Teacher Conferences



Creating an Account

1. Go to the address for your schoo http://www.parentinterviews.com/benito-school.

The specific address will have been provided by your school. If you don't already have the URL please contact your school.

- 2. Click the Create New Account button.
- 3. Enter your name, email address, phone number, and choose a password.
- 4. Click Continue.

Adding a child to your account

- 1. Click My Account from the main menu.
- 2. Click My Children from the dropdown menu.
- 3. Click Add Child.
- 4. Complete the First Name and Last Name fields.
- 5. Click Continue.

Scheduling Appointments

- 1. Click Make Appointments from the main menu.
- 2. Add a Student to your account by completing the form.
- · if you have already added student(s) to your account you won't see this step
- 3. Select the Student(s) you would like to book appointments for from the list.
- 4. Choose a date, or a specific timespan, from the available options.
- 5. Choose the Teacher(s) which you would like to meet with from the available options.
- if you are scheduling appointments for more than one Student this step will be repeated
- 6. For each Teacher, use the dropdown menus to select from the available appointment times.
- 7. Click **Continue** to reserve your appointment times.
