Qualifications:

Essential:

- Truck and Transport Mechanic Red Seal will be given preference. Consideration may be given to those who hold a Heavy-Duty Red Seal Certificate and can obtain their Truck and Transport Mechanic Certificate.
- Consideration may be given to a high school graduate who has completed their level 1 Heavy Duty apprenticeship and willing to obtain their Red Seal.
- Perform, under supervision of the Transportation Supervisor, ongoing maintenance/repair of school buses, support vehicles and equipment, diagnose mechanical and electrical problems and complete all documentation associated with equipment repairs.
- Possess a valid Manitoba Class 5 Driver's License to Class 2 or be able to obtain a Manitoba Class 2 Driver's License with Air Brake Endorsement.
- Must be physically capable of performing the routine manual labour components of the position, which may include but are not limited to: heavy lifting (up to 100lbs), maneuvering within or around large equipment, exposure to dust, noise, extreme weather conditions, diesel exhaust fumes and chemical agents used in the mechanical field.

Desired:

- Demonstrated ability to work with a minimum of supervision.
- Demonstrated ability to use sound judgement in making decisions.
- Demonstrated acceptable safety and job performance relevant to this position.
- Demonstrated effective interpersonal skills.
