No Violence

No Direct Defiance

Ignoring the rules after direction/redirection	Refusal ex. "NO" verbal or non-verbal	Walking away from a problem solving discussion	Negotiating the rules	Apathy/no acknowledgement ex. lack of ownership
Technology: not handing over a device after 1) warning to put it away 2) Put in office till end of day 3) parent pick up			Swearing/Arguing/Justifying behaviour: blaming, excuses, challenging rules

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WITS: W— walk away I— Ignore it T— Talk it out S— Seek adult help

- **Parental Involvement**
- **Principal or Resource Teacher involvement**
- **Removal of privileges**

- **Behaviour contract**
- **Restitution (Making it right)**
- **Student Suspension**
- **Student Expulsion**
- **Threat Assessment**
- **Police notification**
