Dear Parents,

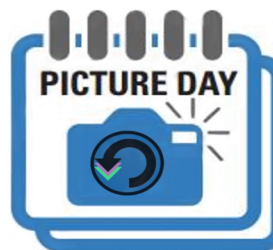
Thank you very much for your continued effort in screening the health of your children daily. It's one of the most powerful things we can do to stop the spread of infection.

All Grades will be tested.

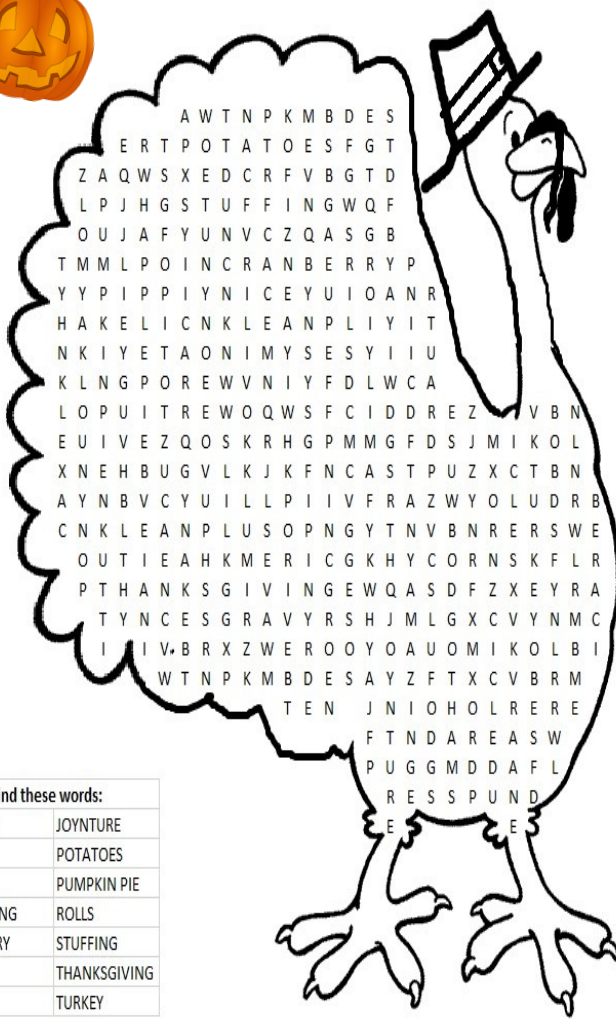
FALL IS HERE...the mornings are cooler! It is important to send your children to school dressed for outdoor recess.
