 PKHC, Auditors for SVSD, reviewed the Audited Financial Statements for the 2016/17 school year with Trustees. The Audited Financial Statements will be posted on our website shortly.

- 2. The Board is serving notice that it will be allowing drug dogs to enter schools and conduct searches. The Board does not feel that our schools have a bigger issue with drugs than other Manitoba Schools; however, it wants to send a message that it will not tolerate drugs on school premises. The first such search will occur within the next few weeks.
- 3. The Superintendent reported that the Youth in Philanthropy Program has started again at SVRSS. The Program has four students. Thanks to Teacher Austen Anderson for his willingness to take on this initiative.
- 4. Kelli Riehl again has been nominated to be the Regional Rep on the MSBA Executive. Election to be held at the MSBA Convention in March.
- 5. Trustees expressed some concern about the slow pace of work being done on the SVRSS wall project. Administration was asked to check with the Contractor.
- 6. SVRSS Administration and the Superintendent visited Sapotaweyak School. The purpose of the visit was to explore areas where partnerships may be formed/developed.
