Sliding Rules



- 1. One student per carpet, unless it is a two-seater.....then, no more than two. Round saucers are okay; only one person per saucer.
- 2. Proper clothing must be worn when sliding. *Toques, mitts and snow pants are all required.*
- 3. Only students with carpets/saucers go down the hill.....students with a partner on a two-seater are okay.....but we don't want freeloaders making it miserable for others.
- 4. Students will stay well to the east of the fence.....no one should be sliding or playing behind it (too close to the walkway and the baseball fence).
- 5. Grades 1, 2 and 5 will use the hill during the first recess while the Kindergarten, Grades 3 and 4 will use it during the last recess. We'll have to go in "shifts" at lunch until the novelty wears off even grades K, 2 & 4 on even days and odd grades 1, 3 & 5 on odd days. The classes should slide in order of oldest closest to the fence with Kindergarten furthest to the northeast. NO SLIDING BEFORE SCHOOL.
- 6. Bumps and ramps will **NOT** be used.
- 7. Please remind students that carpets must be carried with caution....rolled up (sharp edges on cold windy days are weapons!)
- 8. Heads up running back up the hill!
- 9. General good behavior is required or students lose their privilege on the hill. This is important starting the very first day.
- 10. Hopefully, there will still be some who think they'd like to slide!!
